GOVERNOR'S REPORT: 2021/2022

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP AS OF MARCH 02, 2022: 832

Continued to develop and update region website content to increase usage/traffic for communication, recruitment and
retention; added tabs for DE&I & COVID Resources, and a section on Region Documents. New members are directed to
the website in their welcome letter etc.

- Increased internal communication via email, phone, and Zoom sessions (debrief, Q&A sessions etc.) to provide updates, training, coordination of events etc. and to increase the culture and sense of belonging.
- Developed Professional Development Series open to ALL membership at no cost. These included partnerships with local chapters and/or districts to co-sponsor events (NCR, NYC, ENY, Tri-States, CNYFL, NSQ) and/or fully fund innovative programing, DE&I content/topics etc. The idea is to form consortium- type partnerships with music programs, chapters, private academies etc. in order to support programing, share costs and offer diverse opportunities to our membership at no cost. This program serves as recruitment and retention tool; creates a sense of belonging; and increase engagement.

Added several programs for the Annual Regional Student Auditions & Conference.
Diversified geographical areas for hosting main regional events (regional auditions & conference, NATSAA etc.). Comprehensive geographical rotation to avoid centralizing any particular region
Continued to work on issues of <u>Diversity, Equity & Inclusion</u> through programming and strategic planning.
Opened and maintained YouTube Premium and Zoom accounts.
Appointed social media coordinator; linked social media accounts to website to increase easier access; revamped ALL social media accounts.
Appointed region's technical support team.
*Given the peculiarities of this year with the planning, preparation and administration of the Regional NATSAA Auditions and the Regional Students Auditions & Conference (in-person) the bulk of the many meetings and work sessions have been dedicated to those major regional events.
