Typically, the selection process is focused on, but not limited to, individuals who have served/are serving, and/or are linked to the conference host institution, are/or have been members of the local chapter and/or district in which the conference is being held, are/or have been at large members of the Eastern Region.

The host institution/conference hosts will present nomination/s to the regional governor (and auditions team when/if applicable), and to the chapter and/or district for consideration and approval.

As a recipient of this award, the honoree will receive, will participate of, and will be invited to the following:

- Virtual Honoree Awards Ceremony.**
- A recognition plaque (given during the award ceremony).**
- An invitation to guest adjudicate for the final round of the Eastern Region of NATS Student Auditions and/or other, depending upon audition format (in-person vs. virtual)**
- Gift/s**
- Invitation to present a session/workshop/lecture and/or serve as master teacher for the Eastern Region of NATS Student Auditions & Conference, or within Eastern Region of NATS Professional Development Series.**
- Free NATS national membership, beginning the following renewal period, for as long as the honoree desires to remain a NATS member. *This initiative was approved by the NATS Eastern Region Council of Governors on 02/15/2021.**
